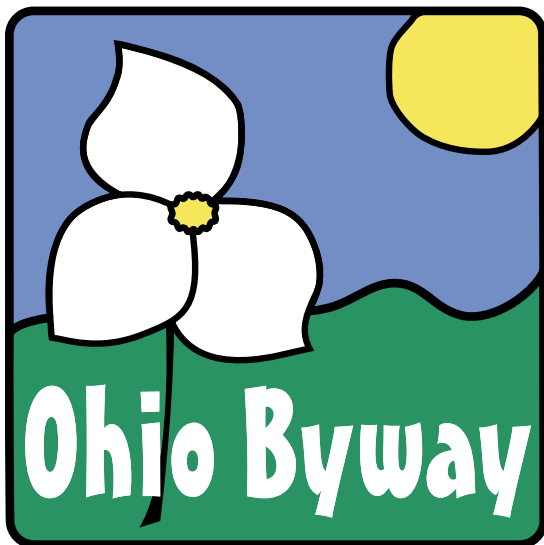


Governor Bob Taft,
