The following additional resident or visitant birds have been added to the previous list: Brown Creeper (March 30, Wade Park; A.T.Stover); Golden Crowned Kinglet (the same); Cardinal (Feb'y 20, Bedford, Mr. C.J.Milz); Goldfinch (one Mar. 28, Macedonia; Mr. A.T.Stover); Ruffed Grouse (two, one drumming; Mar. 28, Macedonia; Mr. Stover); Chickadee (the same); Marsh Hawk (the same); Sparrow Hawk (one, Feb'y 6, Mayfield Rd.); Hairy Woodpecker (five, March 27, Macedonia; Mr. A.T.Stover.

The Mourning Dove seems to be partly a winter resident, as shown by the following quotations: from Macedonia by Mr. Stover; Oct. 3, Dec. 13, 29, Feb'y 3, 24, Mar. 21, 27, 28, Apr 4 (common and cooing): Bedford by Mr. Milz, Mar. 29.
