The total number of trips after birds taken by these observers is 32 in June, 39 in July, and 25 in August.

Censuses of nests or breeding pairs of birds were taken by observers in three different localities. The Baldwin Bird Research Laboratory recorded the following number of nests of fifteen acres immediately surrounding houses, barns, sheds, gardens, etc., at Gates Mills:
