 Bulletin No. 3 – June, July, August

This bulletin covers the nesting season from June 1 to August 31. Continuing our policy of last summer, we are including in this bulletin several censuses of nesting birds over known acreage and definite uniform habitat. This should be of interest in describing a little more clearly the habitat distribution of our summer birds and the actual abundance of each species in those localities.

Mr. John Aldrich sends in two such censuses of nesting birds in Solon Bog, about 25 miles southeast of Cleveland. In 17 acres of rush-buttonbush-swamp-rose marsh, the following pairs of birds were found breeding:

The number of nesting pairs here is estimated to be approximately 82, which is an average of 5.5 pairs per acre.

The record of birds seen on trips taken by Bird Club members is given below. The number of species listed in this record is 134, of which 6 are new for the year. These new species bring the total seen during the year up to 206.

Three records on this list are of especial interest: the golden-winged warbler that was found mated to a blue-winged warbler; slate-colored juncos found nesting on Little Mountain; and the invasion of egrets. Eighteen individual egrets were recorded during the summer in widely separated localities. Other records of egrets have also come to our attention from observers in Toledo and Youngstown, so that the irregular northward movement of this species after the concluding of its breeding season in the south appears to have been unusually pronounced this year. Why does this movement occur so frequently in this group of birds and apparently in no other?
